First, that the book was to be for those who wished to build for themselves; not for their architects, nor for speculators. Secondly, that only a single class of house was to be discussed - namely, one designed for gentlefolk and their servants, but not costing more than about 1000. It has ever been the case since the architect became a professional man, and ceased to employ his own masons, that one of his chief difficulties has been to impart to his client a proper understanding of the building he proposes to erect. Plans and elevations give a diagram of the dry bones; a perspective view may give the general outline, but neither of these will carry any conviction to the lay mind without..
