The figures are based on the official figures (some gross, some net) of the various governments. It shows the tonnage of principal nations, and tonnage added annually for a term of years. Tables 2 and 3 are from the annual volumes of the great classification societies-- Lloyd s and the Bureau Veritas. The minimum tonnage recognized by these societies is considerably higher than the legal basis of official returns of any government. Neither society takes any cognizance in its statistics of steam vessels of less than 100 tons. Gross and net tonnage are stated by both, and comparison of Table 1 with Tables 2 or 3 will indicate where net tonnage is employed in Table 1. Both societies consider only net tonnage in the case of sailing vessels, Lloyd S...
